THE BARLOW TYRIE HISTORY

Barlow Tyrie was founded in 1920 by Frederick Barlow and Victor Tyrie in London. They quickly gained a reputation for their outdoor furniture, made almost entirely by hand and to the highest standards

In 1967 Peter, son of the founder Victor Tyrie, joined the company and in order to increase production levels relocated to a new factory at Braintree, outside of London. Growing demand for the company's products has resulted in the steady expansion of this factory, which now occupies 90,000 ft² / 8,000 m². The company expanded further in 1986 when it set up its American subsidiary in New Jersey. However, the company remains a family business and is now in its 3rd generation with Peter's sons, James and Mark, working in sales and design.

THE BARLOW TYRIE QUALITY PROMISE

The Barlow Tyrie furniture is of the highest quality. Firstly, they use quality materials; the highest grade of teak (*tectona grandis*), marine-quality solid brass and stainless steel fittings. Secondly, their designs are always created with careful attention to form and proportion. Thirdly, the quality of their construction, using our traditional and tested methods.

Barlow Tyrie have combined these elements to produce many pieces in their range that are design classics, which are frequently copied. The result is worldwide recognition of the Barlow Tyrie brand as representing the best in outdoor furniture. To their renowned range of the highest grade teak furniture, Barlow Tyrie have now added Textilene, Jacquatex, stainless steel and aluminium, to produce contemporary designs to the same high standard.

Equinox

Launched in 2004/5, this is a modern design which combines warm teak with contemporary stainless steel and high tech textilene fabric (PVC coated polyester yarn that will withstand years of outdoor use). This award winning design has proved very popular and a high dining range including chairs, stools and tables has been added to the Equinox range for 2006. These are in addition to stacking arm and side chairs, loungers, circular, rectangular and square dining tables, coffee and side tables and stacking loungers.

Eclipse

A new contemporary range from Barlow Tyrie, this combines teak with virgin aluminium and textilene fabric. The aluminium frames of the Eclipse range are powder coated in 3 different colours: graphite, arctic white and quicksilver. The chair slings and backs come in four different colours. The range currently comprises stacking armchairs and a circular dining table.

Monaco

A very popular teak range that features a clean Scandinavian design theme. This is an extensive range with all outdoor seating and dining options covered. The folding carver and side chairs have a contoured backrest for added support, a polished brass handle to aid folding and an easy to use brass safety lock. A superb folding chair that is as delightful to use as it is on the eye. The armchair and side chair have a gently curving shape, contoured back and seat, which makes them comfortable even without a cushion. Great on comfort and great on style. There is also a Monaco Recliner chair, high dining carver and side chair, sun lounger as well as landscape seats to cover all seating options. Matching tables come in coffee and rectangular dining options. Seat cushions are available in 5 colours to go with all seats, chairs and loungers.

Glenham

The Glenham range of teak landscape seating is traditionally styled and includes benches, corner, circular, hexagonal and children's seats. Cushions are available to go with this range.

Capri Loungers

This classic teak sun lounger has been gracing poolsides, decks and terraces for many years. Its simple clean lines are appreciated around the world. There are four versions to select from and its base loungers may be clipped together to achieve double, triple or tete a tete configurations. Lounger cushions are available to go with this range.

Adirondack

Deep, angled seat and high curved back that combine to produce an extremely comfortable chair.
